Practical Advice You Can Use

Tips on How to Take Better Club Photos with your Phone

- 1 Keep your camera lens clean and battery charged
- 2 Think Rule of Thirds Imagine that your photo is divided into 9 equal sections with grid lines. Try to have your subjects along where the grid lines cross to create a balanced photo.
- 3 Make sure stray items are removed from the picture i.e., name tags, water bottles, etc.
- 4 Natural light is best. But artificial light needs to be placed where your subjects' faces are not in the shadow.
- 5 Don't zoom crop your photo.
- Take a lot of photos to get the best shot. Use the burst function on your phone to take a series of rapid photos so that you can get the best one out of the group.
- 7 If taking a selfie with club friends take from an angle and with the camera being held higher than your faces.
- 8 Make your club photos interesting! Remember fun photos on your club's website and Facebook page can help you attract new members.
