Encourage active participation in the legislative process by providing information about major bills in both the U. S. Congress and the Texas Legislature.

But, don't stop there! Research and follow city council, county commissioner court, and school board agendas.

Read NFRW and TFRW emails - TFRW "President's Newsletter," and email alerts.

Follow legislators and elected officials on social media.

Login to the TFRW website and check out the Legislative page.

Develop working relationships with the local offices of federal and state representatives (U.S. Senators, U.S. Congressman, State Senator, and State Representative). Sign up for notifications from each office.

Build a legislative file on major issues and publish legislative updates in the Local Club newsletter.
