Recap for Legislative Day and TFRW Board of Director's Meeting held March 22 in Austin, TX

The TFRW State Convention is a biennial event with the 2025 convention being held in San Antonio in October.

At the Board of Directors meeting last month, TFRW Past President Kit Whitehill presented potential locations for the 2027 Convention (our 36th Biennial Convention). We had 5 venues from across Texas showcase their convention sites. Everyone was excited to hear the winning presentation, and the announcement that Moody Gardens in Galveston, TX will be hosting us in 2027.

As a TFRW Patron, I had the privilege to join 100 plus other Patrons in a visit to the Governor's Mansion in Austin.

A perfect ending to the afternoon was a visit and photo with Ceclia Abbott.

That evening we enjoyed a dinner with Elected Officials. Speaker of the House, Dustin Burrows, gave updates on the current legislative session, along with Secretary of State Jane Nelson. Governor Abbot was scheduled to attend; however, he was asked to a meeting at the White House to meet with our leaders in Washington D.C. It is so awesome for our Governor to be invited to assist our Nation in such a manner!

As part of our Legislative Day training, we heard from Senator Cornyn as well as Steve Munisteri who served as chairman to the Republican Party of from 2010 to 2015.
